2	Almondsbury Social Club then Almondsbury Creative	Almondsbury	Still there, alley in place but no BNWSL teams use.
3	Anchor Hotel	Filton	Still there, Now called the Air Balloon pub but no alley.
4	Anchor Pub	Bishopston	Still there, but no alley
5	Ardagh Sports Club	Horfield	Still there, no longer appear to have an alley.
6	Ashley Down OB	Lockleaze	Now Lockleaze Sports Centre, no alley.
7	Avonmouth RFC	Avonmouth	Still there, but no alley
8	BAC Sports Pavilion, then BAWA	Southmead	Still there, and used by BNWSL Teams.
9	Beehive	Henleaze	Still there, no alley.
10	Blue Boy, then The Gainsborough	Lockleaze	Now demolished, empty lot in place.
11	BOCM Club, then Bristol & West Sports Club	Portway	No more, now empty grass area with whale sculptures!
12	Bourne End	Brentry	No more, demolished and replaced by housing
13	Bristol North RFC	Almondsbury	Still there, no alley.
14	Britannia	Patchway	Demolished, Office Building now in its place.
15	Brunswick Club	St Pauls	Still there, but empty building
16	Bulldog	Filton	Still there, but no alley
17	Civil Service Sports Club	Horfield	Still there, and used by BNWSL Teams.
18	Clifton Rugby Club	Cribbs Causeway	Still there, but doesn't appear to have an alley.
19	County Ground Hotel	Bishopston	Now the Sportsman Pub & Annexe
20	Downend Tavern	Downend	Closed, but now reopened -unclear if alley exists
21	Duke of York	Horfield Common	Now The Crafty Cow, no alley
22	Eastfield Inn	Henleaze	Still there, alley in place but no BNWSL teams use.
23	Eastville Social Club	Eastville	Still there, not clear if alley remains

24	English Rose	Lawrence Weston	Demolished 1998., believe housing now in place.
25	Fellowship Hotel	Horfield	Now a Tesco Express
26	Filton Ex-Services, then Filton & District Social Club	Filton	Still there, and used by BNWSL Teams.
27	Filton Sports & Leisure Centre, inc. The Ratepayers	Filton	Leisure centre was refurbished and still there. Ratepayers is now closed. No alley on site.
28	Frenchay Hospital Social Club	Frenchay	Now demolished, housing on site
29	Giant Goram	Lawrence Weston	Now closed, but community trying to reopen.
30	Gloucester CCC, Jessops Tavern	County Ground	Demolished, new stand replaced it, now Flats.
31	Golden Bottle	Lockleaze	Demolished, housing being built on site
32	Hallen Recreational Centre	Hallen	Still there, but indications are temporarily closed.
33	Hambrook Social Club	Hambrook	Still there, and used by BNWSL Teams.
34	Harriers Sport & Leisure Club	Little Stoke	Now a gym.
35	Henbury Inn	Henbury	No more, housing now on site.
36	Henbury Social Club	Henbury	Closed 2021, now an empty building
37	Horfield & Bishopston Unionist Club, then Bristol County Conservative Club	Horfield	Now Nevil Road Community Club
38	Horfield Inn, then the Bristol Flyer	Bishopston	Still there, now called the Flyer, no alley
40	King George VI	Filton	Now a Paint & Decorating Shop
41	King William IV	Hallen	Still there, but appears no alley
42	Kings Arms	Blackboy Hill	Still there, but no alley
43	Lawrence Weston Social Club	Lawrence Weston	Still there, unclear if alley facilities exist
44	Little Stoke Social Club	Little Stoke	Still there, and used by BNWSL Teams.
45	Manor Farm Social Club	Portway	Still there, and used by BNWSL Teams.
46	Masons Arms	Lawrence Weston	Demolished 2011, housing now on site
47	Memorial Stadium	Horfield	Still there, no alley.
48	New Inn	Patchway	Became the Travellers Rest (Hungry Horse), now an abandoned building,
49	North Bristol Social Club	Eastville	Now closed, converted to housing

50	P.B.A Social club	Shirehampton	Still there, alley in place but no BNWSL teams use.
51	Patchway British Legion Club	Patchway	Demolished, Office Building now in its place.
52	Patchway Labour Club	Patchway	Headquarters for BNWSL.
53	Patchway Sports & Social Club	Patchway	Closed 2024, Now an empty building
54	Penpole Inn	Lawrence Weston	Demolished, housing now stands on site.
55	Progress Inn, then Iron Bridge	Sea Mills	Now a nursery.
56	Railway Inn	Patchway	Formerly Toyota Cars but now an empty lot.
57	Rainbow Club, then Parkway Tavern	Stoke Gifford	Became a Supermarket, now an Empty building
58	Royal George	Filton Rd	Still there, now called Inn on the Green, no alley.
59	Royal Navy Association Club	Sea Mills	Now housing.
60	Southmead Community Association	Southmead	Still there, and used by BNWSL Teams.
61	Southmead Hospital Social Club	Southmead	Demolished when hospital rebuilt.
62	Southmead Rugby Club	Southmead	Still there, and used by BNWSL Teams.
63	St Andrews Bowling Club	St Andrews	Still there, alley in place but no BNWSL teams use.
64	St Teresa`s Social Club	Filton	Behind St Teresas Church, building still exists, use unknown
65	St. Bonaventures Parish Club	Bishopston	Now a business centre
66	Standard of England	Southmead	Demolished, Tesco Express on its site.
67	Stapleton & Begbrook Community Association	Frenchay	Still there, and used by BNWSL Teams.
68	The Bell Hotel	Stapleton	Now demolished, residential houses
69	The Magpie	Little Stoke	Still there, now called The Stokers, no alley.
70	Winterbourne Comm Assn	Winterbourne	Still there with alley, not used by any BNWSL teams.
